Skillfully turned from servicewood, a warm-coloured hardwood usually reserved for tool handles, these candlesticks have a grippy shaft, making them easy to grasp and use; An imperceptible difference characterizes them, which attests to their craftsmanship and their age without denouncing that they form a pair; the elegance that characterizes them makes them a beautiful adornment of the top of a small piece of furniture or the center of a table for a tête-à-tête. The hard wood which constitutes them has generated some small cracks on their lower parts without altering their solidity or their appearance. The terminal ring has one of the vases has undergone a very small "cosmetic" barely noticeable recovery. Free shipping for France.
