Description

Pair of 19th century German porcelain dishes in the style of the 18th century. Square in shape, they are decorated with finely painted animated country scenes. One represents a couple at work: the man draws water and the woman who has recovered a full bucket pours the contents into a stone trough in order to water her sheep which are waiting in the back under the supervision of 'a dog. The other depicts a very different scene: we are also in the middle of nature but the characters are not at work but on a walk: a young woman holding a parasol is walking accompanied by a young man and a small pet dog.; at the back is a tower that is probably part of a castle. The painter wanted to show the contrast between 2 very different worlds although located in similar frameworks: on the one hand work, on the other
