painter who had his first exhibition in 1927, is a Hendri painter who had his first exhibition in 1978 in Paris. He began to paint watercolors, oils on canvas, then discovered what would be his favorite material: sand. Sand from deserts around the world. This material was brought to him by a member of his family, then a desert geologist. He participated in numerous exhibitions as well as salons, for nearly forty years. Poetry, sensitivity, purity, plenitude and tranquility emerge from his abstract works.
