**BIOGRAPHY** Born April 9, 1944 Official Navy painter approved in 2003 Official Navy painter holder in 2012 Jean-Marie ZACCHI, born April 9, 1944, graduated from the Ecole Supérieure des Arts Modernes in Paris. by Jean-Marie Zacchi began in 1963, at the age of 19, during his first exhibition as part of the Salon des Artistes français at the Grand Palais. In 1973, he was part of the Fine Arts Commission of Boulogne where he participated in the creation of the first salon "Language du Dessin". He exhibited at the Salon of the Société Nationale d'Horticulture de France, where from 1981 he took on the role of Exhibition Commissioner for the Fine Arts section. In 1986, he became a member of the Salon Violet Committee (former Salon des Palmes Académiques), in 1989 he was elected

vice-president, then in 1990 he chaired the Salon Violet. Elected in 1986 to the Committee of the Society of French Artists, he became in 1988: Secretary of the Painting section then in 1989 he was elected general commissioner of the salons. This same committee elected him President in 1991, he succeeded Arnaud d'Hauterives, member of the Institute. He assumed the presidency of the Society of French Artists for 3 years. The Medal of Honor was awarded to him in 1991. The Salon des Artistes Français presented a retrospective of his works at the Grand Palais in Paris in 1992. In 1994, Jean Marie Zacchi was elected Honorary President of the Society of French Artists. In 1991, he was elected vice-president of the Federation of Graphic and Plastic Arts Associations in liaison with the public authorities. In 1991, Jean-Marie Zacchi was appointed Official Painter of the Army. He assumed the presidency from 2005 to 2009. In 1997, the Federation of Sports and Artistic Clubs of Defense (FCSAD) elected him a member of the Steering Committee. very pretty painting by ZACCHI (on the other side of the pont de marie in paris) signed and countersigned on the back jean marie zacchi In 2010 was named Honorary President of the Official Painters of the Army.
