Spelter with medal patina, by the German sculptor Henry Weïsse (19th-20th century), signed on the embankment. This test features a firefighter from the city of Paris, under the Third Republic, in full action. The fire soldier, a spear in hand, is posted on a roof, more precisely on a roof window, trying to put out a fire. This sculpture rests on a circular pedestal in ash with a faux red cherry marble patina. Testimony of these heroes who fight tirelessly to save lives, "Soldier of Fire" is a work faithfully produced and stamped with authenticity. ******* Period: 19th century Excellent condition.
