Revealed to the Parisian public at the Salon des Indépendants in 1920. Exhibits in Paris, Brussels, Geneva, Italy, Stockholm, London, New York, present in the museums of Le Havre, Libourne, Rouen. St Etienne, Amsterdam, Tunis. Here very beautiful bouquet of tulips. Strong and powerful, warm colors, not to be missed! Superb painting with a beautiful Montparnasse frame in the format of 64x55 cm and 46x38 cm without.
