Master's degree obtained on September 22, 1756 "Jean-René Nadal is the eldest son of Jean Nadal, carpenter, and the daughter of his colleague Jean Cresson. He is also the brother of Jean-Michel Nadal, himself a carpenter. Nadal took over the rue de Cléry workshop - probably after the death of his father - and decided to establish himself in the same street under the sign of the "Lion d'Argent".
