### Description

Percussion pistol and forced bullet in its box, 2nd Empire period, NAPOLEON III, 19th century.

Pistol with damascus barrel unscrewable with strong stripes, engraved on its whole and carrying rear sight in "V", caliber 12 mm. Folding and built-in trigger in the chest, crested dog, Renaissance-type ebony stock sculpted with floral engraving and ending in a diamond-type metal cap. Mechanism in perfect working order.

Weapon length: 16 cm Barrel length: 5.7 cm In its lockable walnut box, key present. Box with compartments containing lead bullets, swab with boxwood knob, powder measure of "4 grs" with boxwood knob, a bullet mold with its key square for unscrewing the barrel and bearing No. 31. A box in brass with primers and a screwable boxwood box with volume of black powder.
