Description

A Regence period tortoise shell and brass marquetry bracket clock with its base. The bracket clock is surmounted by a figure wearing a helmet and holding a bird. Below the dial a heron - symbol of perpetual rebirth and a female figure holding an oil lamp and a book with the inscription *Ultima latet - La dernière (heure) t'est cachée*. Chiselled gilt bronze ornamentation. White enameled dial with Roman numerals for hours and Arabic numerals for minutes on a background decorated with stylized flowers and leaves. The plate of the mechanism signed "Bonneval à Paris". Scrolls ornamentation. Wire movement. Running order. Little accidents on the marquetry. France. 18th century.
