Charles Catteau (1880-1966)

Franco-Belgian ceramist. After an experience at the factory of Nymphenburg near Munich, he became responsible for the decoration workshop of the Manufacture de

La Louviere, Boch Keramis, from 1907 to 1947.

He will be successful, and he will leave many vases including renowned sandstone, with stylized motifs drawn from fauna and flora.

Vittorio Bonuzzi (1900-1972) was a fix collaborator fixe of l'Atelier de Fantaisie between 1928 and 1960
