Son of the painter Henri Dillens, he followed
courses at the Academy of Brussels and modeling
with Eugene Simonis. He collaborates as a
worker on various projects, including the Brussels
Stock Exchange, where he meets Carrier-Belleuse
and Rodin.

He participated in the exhibitions of the Essor group, which included Fernand Khnopff, Léon Frédéric and James Ensor.

In 1877, he won the Prix de Rome and traveled in France and Italy. Julien Dillens also created memorials and funerary monuments.
