Watercolor on paper by Jean Vinay, French painter born in 1907 in Saint-Marcellin, Dauphiné and died in 1978 in L'Albenc. Signed and dated 1930 lower right. Good condition. Framed, under glass. Dimensions at sight: 30 X 23 cm. Frame dimensions: 42 X 33 cm. From 1933, after his secondary studies, Jean Vinay settled in Paris, in Montmartre and decided to become a painter. He works relentlessly, training mainly in museums. From the beginning of the German occupation, he went to Algiers to a childhood friend and met Albert Marquet who lent him his studio. Back in Paris in 1946, success took shape very quickly. He meets many painters who become his friends, exhibits in several large galleries and participates in the most important artistic events. He quickly becomes a great name in painting and will be
