This large Falcon Gyr is digitally remastered and printed on acid-free cotton rag paper with archival inks. These Giclee prints are from scans of the original watercolors. (#1 Das grosse Vogelbuch des Olof Rudbeck d. J Belser Verlag - Zurich, 1985) Olof Rudbeck the Younger (1660-1740) was born and educated in Uppsala, Sweden, where he received an excellent education from his father and other qualified teachers. He studied medicine, and his thesis *De propagatione plantarum*, published in 1686, is considered to mark the birth of modern botany in Sweden. The so-called Great Book of Birds by Olof Rudbeck the Younger is a work begun ca. 1693 but was never published until a facsimile was made in 1985. Rudbeck continued to give a series of ornithological lectures between 1727
