## Description

Oval porcelain cup in a bronze and gilded brass mount, in the style of Sèvres porcelain with a royal blue background receiving two cartouches underlined by a gilt frame of garlands of leaves and flowers:

Coat of arms surmounted by a crown of marquis framed by two dogs, all placed on a vignette. Representing two groves in the foreground framing a landscape of hills in the background. The cup is set in a fine quadripod mount in bronze and gilded brass, decorated with acanthus leaves, stylized lion muzzles, two of the eagle claw feet holding a sphere.

Two scrolled handles hold the ring covering the high border of the porcelain.

Very good condition of the gilding, with the exception of the brass ring which has been
