These two panels are made of lacquer, they weigh a significant weight of 5 kilograms each, they are made of wood, probably exotic ironwood. Everything is in high relief with work in mother-of-pearl, probably in stone too, everything is beautifully hand-painted with great finesse. There is a scene with a dignitary perhaps a public writer, there is a peasant with a pig, another scene represents dancers with the drums of the vegetation. There are hard stones, everything is of high quality and very decorative. Attention, there is wear on the perimeter with lack of lacquer, friction and wear on the characters, lack of paint, a depression on one of the panels, we took as many photos of the defects as possible. .Sold uncleaned, as is, unrestored.
