Description

Covered box or bonbonniere in blown Murano glass in the shape of an apple, decorated with cobalt blue and celeste blue dappled inclusions on a translucent ground, the lid surmounted by a small conical brass finial. Murano, Italy. 20th century, circa 1960-1970. H_10 cm D_12 cm. Good overall condition. During the 1960s and 1970s, Murano master glassmakers distinguished themselves through the creation of utilitarian and decorative trompe-l'oeil objects inspired by flora and fruit, exploiting the technique of colored pigment inclusions (macchie or macchiato). Our piece fits into the mid-20th-century Italian art glassware production, combining the playfulness of fruit-inspired motifs with the technical craftsmanship of color inclusions in solid glass.
