During the war, she studied at the School of Arts and Crafts in Krakow, then studied again at the Academy of Fine Arts with Hanna Rudzka-Cybisowa and Eugeniusz Eibisch. As a member of the Association of Polish Artists and Designers, Lipez has participated in numerous group exhibitions, including the Polish Association of Artists and Designers, BWA Gallery and the National Museum in Warsaw. His works have also been presented in solo
