Description

This is a poster created by Théophile-Alexandre Steinlen (1859-1923) to promote the French chocolate and tea company in 1895. The poster features a scene from the artist's personal life, with his wife and her daughter at breakfast. The woman is drinking Chinese black tea, while the girl is holding a cup of hot chocolate and watching over their pet cat, which is sitting nearby. It was printed by Imp. Courmont Freres in Paris. The poster is widely recognized as a masterpiece of the Art Nouveau style and is referenced in various art databases, such as Bargiel & Zagrodzki, Crauzat, DFP-II, Timeless Images, Gold and PAI-LXX.
