Bicentenary bonnetière in Louis XV style in solid Cherry, with reasonable dimensions. It opens with a door with two asymmetrical panels fitted with applied iron hinges, as well as a lock and an original entrance of the same alloy, accompanied by its key. The upper crosspiece of this opening is slightly cut and molded from the inside. This furniture is surmounted by a molded cornice in a soft and rounded way. On each side, two receding half-round legs with cut-outs soften the volume of this property: these end in a doe-foot with an elegant curve, and frame a low crosspiece with cutouts and mouldings. This Bonnetière offers an interesting storage capacity, its interior being fitted out with three shelves resting on adjustable cleats on racks: note that we can also design an additional shelf for you if necessary.
