Beautiful facade of cherry wood paneling opening with 2 Louis XV style doors from the 19th century Doors fitted with double panels with very deep molding Note a superb guilloché keyhole decorated with flowers and a profile The bottom crosspiece is very cut with 1 beautiful hem on the edge as well as a marquetry diamond in its center The uprights end with very pronounced shell feet The cornice is well proportioned and gives a beautiful movement to the whole The hinges, the lock and the key are d origin Very fine workmanship from the beginning of the 19th century Superb honey tint of the cherry wood Beautiful patina The keyhole is also exceptional for its size Work quite in the style of the 18th century: deep moldings, very thick doors... h: 241 .5 cm width: 134.5 cm cornice
