Claude Firmin is listed in Bénézit as well as in the Alauzen Dictionary of Painters and Sculptors of Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur, Bibliography (source Wikipedia): He exhibited at the Salon of French artists from 1889 to 1922; he obtained an honorable mention there in 1902. A member of the group of Thirteen chaired by Clément Brun, he is considered a Provençal master of painting. He became a professor in 1922, then director of
