At the hips, patch pockets on the outside with straight flaps. Comfort openings in the lower part on the sides closing with a button. At the level of the left hip, support leg of the belt, reinforced by a piece of leather, closing with a button of the model. Absence of lining as a rule on the jackets of first manufacture. France. First World War. Very good condition, some moth holes.
