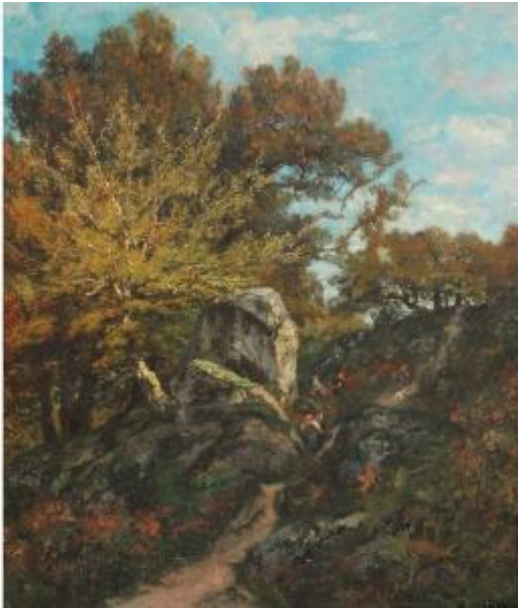

Pupil of Paul Delaroche, belonging to the current of followers of Daubigny, he exhibited at the Salon from 1848.
