the crosspieces are lined with shells and staples.

At the base, a hexagon forming a row of pearls brings together uprights and crosspieces and brings together curved crosspieces with foliage in gilded wood meeting in the lower part in the center of the lantern.

it is the same at the top with the meeting of the uprights thanks to strongly curved and carved crosspieces meeting at the top by a crown in gilded wood.

the set is in excellent condition.

the electrification has been overhauled and works. an elaborate trimming hides the electric wires and the dominoes thanks to an adjustable pavilion in green fabric.

the glasses are in good condition and already old. a very beautiful neo baroque hexagonal lantern around 1900 all in very original and unusual carved wood.
