Ax Kilonda - Democratic Republic Of Congo - First Half Of The 20th Century

Kilonda ceremonial or ceremonial Ax
Songye culture, Democratic Republic of Congo
First half of the 20th century
Wood, iron and copper
Height: 38.5 cm, length: 25.5 cm

The triangular-shaped blade is made of openwork iron with an incised anthropomorphic face on both sides and two knots with twisted strands. It is held in a straight wooden handle wrapped with nailed copper inserts.

The forging of the blade distinguishes it from battle axes and makes this weapon a prestigious object that can sometimes be considered as a bargaining chip.
