SIDEBOARD INLAID IN BOULLE STYLE, BY THE FRENCH CABINETMAKER HYPPOLITE-EDMÈ PRETOT (1812-1855). STAMPED ON THE COVER IN PRETOT WOOD AND NUMBERED 438. ALSO ALL GILDED BRONZES ARE SIGNED H. P. HYPPOLITE PRETOT.

Furniture perfectly restored to rule of art. PRETOT Hippolyte-Edme (1812-1855), born in Paris; married Cyrille-Joséphine Leclercq. He subsequently exercised 16, rue de l'Abbaye in 1836, 11bis, rue Saint-Germain des Près in 1841, and from 1846 3 and 5, rue du Harlay. Shortly after his death, Frédéric Roux bought his company, which was in the meantime managed by cabinetmaker Bassié. He participated in the exhibition in 1849 and the London Exhibition in
