Finely hand-painted, they feature delicate floral compositions and exotic birds in flight, rendered in a harmonious palette of soft blues, greens, and iron reds. The decoration reflects the chinoiserie influence that characterized Chantilly porcelain during the Rococo period. The Chantilly mark on these pieces is that of Maison Samson, a highly esteemed workshop at the time. The gilt bronze mounts enhance the porcelain beautifully, adding richness and sophistication.
