Pretty 18th century perfume bottle, blown and cut glass, screw neck, its glass stopper, its hallmarked silver stopper, it is contained in a small cylindrical case of lacquered wood "Martin varnish" pearl gray background with decor of bands , red and gold color, internal shell sleeve, small golden rings.

Louis XVI period; for 250 years, it has had a lot of problems, more or less well repaired. I put a red arrow on pictures for everything that annoys. Glass stopper is blocked, which has preserved the 18th century fragrance!

Average condition, quite a few signs of wear, I take this into account in my price, but rare item.... 11cm x 2.5cm for the case, 8.5cm x 1.6cm for the bottle.
