



## 2 Onion Candlesticks, Early Eighteenth Century, Quality Bronzes

### Description

This is not a pair.. I tried to show it as much as possible on my detailed photos. Beautiful set of two bronze candlesticks, of a very similar model: octagonal base with double border, cylindrical plate at the base of the shaft, bulbs with several evolutions including a central "onion", and head with a straight neck and integrated bobèche, as well as wax evacuation hole. Blocking of the two parts joined by a manufactured screw thread, intact, everything's genuine from the period! Good overall condition. On one, a slight break at the top of the collar under the bobèche, and on the other a break on the bobèche. Thank you for looking carefully at my photos, I'm not hiding anything!
