Description

Magnificent Persian Isfahan or Isfahan in hand-knotted wool for 560,000 knots per m2. This collector's item is 133 cm wide by 208 cm long. Sublime decor for this type of Persian considered to be the finest carpets found in Iran, between 4 and 6 mm thick. The colors of natural origin mixes apricot, ivory, straw yellow, giving the impression of gold in contrast with striking blues Museum quality carpets. Period end of the 19th century, beginning of the 20th century The decoration of this room takes up colors and traditional floral motifs that appear in carpets from the 16th and 17th centuries and in mosques, on old ceramics from the Safavid period. Models with many similarities to ours are present at the Golestan Palace Museum, at the Carpet Museum in Tehran, Iran (photo of these pieces on request

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for information) and in other museums and collections. One easily recognizes in the interlacing of the palms, almond blossoms often tied on these carpets. The border and its counter-borders are very sophisticated, so fine is the arrangement of interlacing and flowers, we recognize lilies and lotus flowers accompanied by arabesques. The design of the central medallion is specific to these carpets with elegant extensions in large pendants in the design of pendants, and the patterns of the angles show great research.

Pile and edges in very good condition, the restored fringes are very beautiful. A slight discoloration on the top of the carpet, but this does not affect the quality of the piece, quite the contrary. We find substantially the same medallions among the ancient Kachan and Tabriz of the same period. We have great difficulty in imagining the infinite patience that was needed yesterday and that is needed today for the creation of such beautiful pieces. # Carpet
