A rarity that has come down to us in good condition.

a very imposing glass globe from the Napoleon III period decorated with a bouquet of wax fruits resting in a capodimonte porcelain vase decorated with characters.

this type of very decorative globe has become rare today because over time the fruits in wax age badly and the glass globes are often damaged. here our fruit bouquet is in good condition and the colors have remained bright: grapes, apples, peaches, plums, exploded pomegranates... the whole remained in good condition and would possibly just need a little refreshment. the bouquet rests in a porcelain cup decorated with figures and flowers in high relief, probably capodimonte.

24 grande Rue Nogent l'Artaud 02 310 the gilding of this porcelain shaped piece protected by the glass globe is magnificent and the colors have remained very beautiful. the imposing glass globe is in perfect condition and rests on its gilded wooden base decorated with original stucco floral motifs. some small gaps in the floral decoration in stucco without gravity and visible in the photos. the globe offers a two-sided decor. a rare object due to its imposing dimensions and whose decoration of wax fruits has stood the test of time very well.
