He befriends Eugène Boudin whom he met in Honfleur.

A painter of seascapes and landscapes, his compositions are inspired by those of Dutch painters of the 17th century: a first body of water, a strip of land and the sky, a clear palette, colors of great finesse and a sensitive rendering. light.

He started at the Paris Salon in 1848 and exhibited there until 1882.
He obtained medals in 1870 and 1882.
