

A gifted young musician earns money by playing the flute, and his sister, sitting next to him, is ready at any moment to quench her young brother's thirst on a hot day. Unique and original masterwork. That may lead to Eduard Ansen-Hofmann (1862-1955), Austrian painter of Oriental motives, nudes, odalisques etc, highly professional, prolific and gifted painter. At the turn of the century, the Viennese painter Eduard Ansen-Hofmann (1862-1955) became known with his oriental slave market and harem scenes including female nudes.
