Description

I present here a Compagnon Marqueteur piece of furniture from the middle of the 20th century in the Louis XVI style with two trays richly decorated with precious wood nets with a pattern of frames and lozenges on a rosewood background in ebony lemon rosewood and green wood for the nets, square tapered legs covered with an equally precious work, the drawer front (with abutment) just as neat as the four sides, which makes it a beautiful piece of furniture in the middle, visible from everywhere, frames and nets in the upper part, and above all bright and clear by the choice of essences and pattern; the top has a gallery open to the front and the spacer top is completely surrounded by a beautiful gallery, bronze clogs and retractable handles in chiseled and polished bronze, very much in the
