Unfortunately, it is very damaged, with poor restoration (it has the merit of existing). Note rubbing and wear of decoration and gilding, micro-scratches from use, small deformations on the collar, bites, lacks on the decorations of the perimeter, however it remains in an acceptable state of preservation for the 'era.
