An unusual high carat gold ring set with two Roman chromium chalcedony intaglios.

The intaglios date to the 1st - 2nd century AD, the high carat gold ring is modern.

The intaglios measure:

1.1 x 0.75cm and 1 x 0.7cm.

Ring size Q 1/2 UK / 8.25 US.

One intaglio is carved with the image of an elderly man seated before a column, the other with the figure of the sun god Sol. Dealer
