The Pays Pourlet is also characterized by its furniture. There is a unique furniture of its kind where the inlay work holds an important place. The oak or beech wood blackened with moisture alternates with the clarity of the yew or boxwood to realize decorations such as: ears of wheat, roses of the winds, stars. Nails are used to emphasize the ends of the inlays. The headdress and costumes from the Pourleth country are
