Extremely rare Isfahan rug, made of silky lamb's wool velvet called Kork, dating from the Shah period, around 1965 of the Pahlavi dynasty. Characterized by flowers surrounded by silk on a silk foundation, remarkable finesse of workmanship and extraordinary originality. Description: ivory field with branches of several garlands and scrolls of flowers and foliage, adorned with two floral wreaths encrusted with birds encircling a large circular central medallion encrusted with starry floral bulbs in the shape of diamonds and in the shape of old pink mosque dome stained glass windows , ruby and pearl gray. also consists of three borders, the main beige decorated with a thousand flowers in the shape of gold burst diamonds Density: 10,000 knots per dm2.
