### Description

Small glazed and sculpted wedding armoire 19th century in oak Originating from Upper Normandy: Eure - Risle Valley With 3 bouquets of flowers applied to the facade Glass doors decorated with medallions with bouquets of flowers in a basket and acanthus leaves on the very finely carved winding The top of the doors is carved with branches of mistletoe, acanthus leaves and applique flowers The door on the left has 1 false frame carved with a cross of mistletoe leaves and an acanthus leaf in the picture rail The top plinth is carved with branches of mistletoe as well as a large basket in relief with a bouquet of flowers The uprights are carved with crosses of mistletoe leaves The front legs are winding The rear legs are straight The cornice is adorned with a frieze of ovals and Louis XVI style grooves
