Description

Iranian shahsavan wool horse blanket, circa 1940. Very good condition, one or two spots of wear. Rare. Can make a nice wall decoration.

The shahsavans as well as the tribes like the gashghaïs attached a lot of importance to their horses and camels. This authentic horse blanket made in several parts is in djajim*. It was probably intended as a ceremonial cover for ceremonies such as weddings. It is rare to find nowadays these pieces that were part of the life of the nomads.

Note: a braid was placed all around the cover to preserve it.

*djajim: Djajims were made in most Iranian tribes. But we find the majority of djajims among the shahsavans. The weaving technique is
