Franz Otto Scholderer (1834 - 1902) was a German painter.

His work is rooted in Romanticism, with influences from Impressionism.

During his career, he devoted himself first to landscapes, then to portraits and still lifes.

He lived for a long time in Paris and is represented on Henri Fantin-Latour's canvas, *Un atelier aux Batignolles* (1870), alongside Édouard Manet, Auguste Renoir, Zacharie Astruc, Émile Zola, Edmond Maître, Frédéric Bazille, Claude Monet.

Otto Scholderer's works have been auctioned many times, with realized prices ranging from US\$1,042 to US\$108,070, depending on the size
