Pierre-Eugène CLAIRIN (Cambrai 1897 - Saint-Loup-de-Naud 1980), French painter, illustrator and engraver. In 1913, he studied at the Cormon workshop at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris. Demobilized in 1919, he worked at the Académie Ranson with Paul Sérusier, whom he followed to Pont-Aven where he met Vuillard and Maurice Denis.
