Loose coat, crossed in front and closed by bells in matching silk trimmings. Remarkable work of machine stitching forming parallel rolls on the collar, the cuffs and the lapels of the pockets treated obliquely. Belt with passes to tie in front. Last testimony in the fashion of interior dresses for the reception as one can observe in the Hollywood cinema between the two wars. An assumed exoticism! Some rare micro dirt and scratches very difficult to detect, otherwise clean and stable silk. Good general condition of color and conservation. Dimensions: Equivalent size France
