Pretty spelter vases with double patina, green and brown, in the spirit of the works of Auguste Moreau. Each vase is decorated with vegetation representing vine leaves and bunches of grapes. A barrier fixed on the neck of the vases brings a touch of originality to these fittings. On these is a child playing a musical instrument. Wearing a hat and dressed in loose clothing, one of them, barefoot, plays the pipe, while the other practices the bagpipes.
