After the assassination of the Duke of Guise, the leaguers attack the king's supporters. In Toulouse at the beginning of 1589, he sought President Jean-Etienne Duranti, first president of the parliament of Toulouse from 1581 to 1589. On February 10, 1589, he was dragged out of the Dominican convent where he had taken refuge. Duranti appears in front of his opponents in his official clothes and gives a speech to explain his
