Description

Pair of bottle-shaped oil lamps in porcelain, brass and bronze mounted on the lampshade.

The porcelain with a matte black cover is decorated with gold and white cherry blossoms, Coeur de Marie and grasses.

The base and the flange are in bronze, a molded brass spacer assembles the swollen body to the cylinder neck.

Napoleon III period.

Topped with an oval lampshade covered with a linen canvas printed with a decoration of birds perched on branches of cherry blossoms, black and white on a pearl beige background.

Completely revised electrification, wire, socket and bipolar switch in gold color, E27 screw socket.

The electric wire passes inside the lamps.
