Abstract painting signed and attributed to Ferdinand Vonck, oil on canvas around 1950.

Painting signed lower right "Vonck", probably a work of youth, quite a precursor in style. In good condition, recently cleaned and restored, there were three small holes in the canvas (see photos of the back of the painting). Biography:

Ferdinand Vonck said Fernand Vonck (1921 Blankenberge - 2010 Bruges) is a Belgian abstract painter and sculptor. He took courses at the Academy of Bruges but was above all considered self-taught. In 1952, he became a member of the artistic group "Abstract Art" and in 1957 of the group "Forms", co-founders of the group "L'Art Construct" in 1960 (constructivism). Awarded in 1953 by the Province of West Flanders, he received the distinctions of "Young
