In the center, a drawer which makes the width of the piece of furniture, the flap retained by two small chains, which open presents a desk with 2 rows of 3 drawers, and niches. the lower parts also open with two doors. The piece of furniture rests on 4 toupie feet. This piece of furniture is very clean and functional, traces of old restorations, 1 lock present but to be reattached to the center drawer, all the locks are cloverleaf, I have the key!
