Large and beautiful proof in bronze with bronze patina signed Thomas François Cartier (1879 -1943), French animal sculptor known for his passion for dogs, which he represented on numerous occasions. This work depicts a German shepherd standing still, climbing on a rock. Pricked up ears, the agile and elegant dog wears a wide collar that one imagines in studded leather. His posture is slender and his fur shiny. The signature is affixed on the terrace.
