French Labour XIXth Stamped MILLET IN PARIS, big house at the time. Very elegant little woman office in rosewood marquetry geometric patterns and gilded bronze. Wearing a green leather with bronze handrails, floor duct feet shoes, keyhole, falls in gilded bronze. Stamped on the pop lock "Millet in Paris", fully furnished with period having undergone any restorations can also be used as table game BIOGRAPHY:.. La Maison Millet was founded in 1853, located 11 rue Jacques-Coeur, and 23 Boulevard Beaumarchais towards 1902-1904. She performed furniture and bronzes, ancient and modern kind. She won a gold medal at the Universal Exhibition of 1889, a Grand Prix in 1900, and also received three diplomas of honor and four gold medals. On March 4, 1902, Theodore Millet asked the curator

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of the Versailles museum permission to copy the large jewelry cabinet of Marie Antoinette, authorization was granted for one month. At the Exhibition of 1900 he presented a jewelry cabinet, with branches sets, pearl necklaces, birds, ect ..., composed and executed by him.
